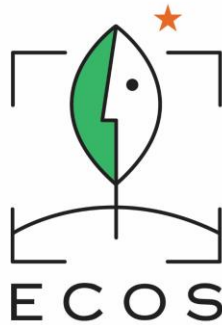

REPRESENTING ENVIRONMENTAL INTERESTS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF EUROPEAN AND INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS ON FIRE SAFETY AND THE USE OF FLAME RETARDANTS IN DIFFERENT PRODUCTS

ECOS is looking for experts with extensive knowledge of fire safety and/or flame retardants to represent environmental interests in the development of standards. Experts will provide technical and scientific input into discussions, in accordance with the related policy context and ECOS strategy.

The nominated expert(s) will represent ECOS in some of the following technical committees:

- IEC TC 108 and CENELEC mirror committee 108x – Safety of ICT Equipment
- IEC/TC 111 and CENELEC mirror committee 111x - Environment
- CEN/TC 207 – Furniture
- CEN/TC 127 – Fire safety in buildings

The nominated experts will be responsible for:

- Participating and promoting ECOS' position in relevant technical committee and working group meetings;
- Preparing technical input e.g. official comments and position papers;
- Reporting to the ECOS Policy Officer and delivering follow-up actions agreed with the ECOS Policy Officer;
- Exchanging information with ECOS member organisations and other experts within dedicated ECOS taskforces.

Interested candidates should be able to illustrate an in-depth knowledge in the topic area of the indicated technical committees. Experience with, and understanding of, the policy context of the topic area will be considered a strong asset. Candidates should also demonstrate a strong commitment to environmental NGO values. Fluency in English is a must.

ECOS will offer:

- Daily remuneration as set out by ECOS funders for preparation of meetings, participation and reporting, as well as for any other tasks performed between meetings;
- Reimbursement of travel costs; and
- Per diem to cover accommodation and subsistence costs.
