**CALL FOR EXPERTS TO REPRESENT THE ENVIRONMENTAL INTERESTS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF EUROPEAN STANDARDS RELATED TO THE DESIGN AND PERFORMANCE OF LAMPS, LUMINAIRES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT.**

ECOS is looking for experts to provide expertise and represent, on behalf of ECOS, the environmental interests in the development of standards related to the design and performance of lamps, luminaires and related equipment.

ECOS is an umbrella organisation representing 38 European environmental NGOs in the development process of European standards and technical product policies. More information is available at [www.ecostandard.org](http://www.ecostandard.org)

In particular, we are looking for experts to represent ECOS in the following groups:

- **IEC/TC 34 'Lamps and related equipment'**, responsible for international standardisation in the field of lamps, LEDs, control gear, luminaires, and related equipment.
- **CLC/TC 34A 'Lamps'**, which prepares European standards based upon finalised international standards (IEC/TC 34) for electrical light sources, including lamps;
- **CLC/TC 34Z 'Luminaires and related equipment'**, responsible for European standards based on concluded international standards (IEC/TC 34) in the lighting field, excluding lamps;
- **CLC/TC 23BX 'Switches, boxes and enclosures for household and similar purposes, plugs and socket outlets for d.c'**, which prepares European standards for the aforementioned purposes.

Tasks of the expert will include:

- To monitor the relevant work of the one or several specific technical committees;
- To participate in and present ECOS' views in the selected standardisation committee meetings and report back to ECOS Secretariat (circa 2-3 meetings a year);
- To prepare technical input and position papers in close collaboration with the ECOS Secretariat;
- To regularly exchange with interested ECOS member organisations and other experts (by e-mail).

Activities are expected to continue throughout 2015 and beyond.

The remuneration of the expert will be as follows:

- Daily expert fees (€ 500,-) for preparation, participation in meetings and reporting, as well as for any other tasks to be performed in between meetings;
- Per diems to cover accommodation and subsistence costs;
- Reimbursement of travel costs.
