**CALL FOR EXPERTS TO REPRESENT THE ENVIRONMENTAL INTERESTS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF
EUROPEAN STANDARDS RELATED TO REFRIGERATION AND AIR-CONDITIONING SYSTEMS**

RESPONSE REQUESTED BY NO LATER THAN THE 16TH SEPTEMBER 2015

ECOS is looking for experts to provide expertise and represent, on behalf of ECOS, the environmental interests in the development of standards related to the design and performance of refrigerating, air conditioning and heat pump (RACHP) systems.

ECOS is an umbrella organisation representing 38 European environmental NGOs in the development process of European standards and technical product policies. More information is available at www.ecostandard.org.

In particular, we are looking for experts to represent ECOS in the following groups:

- **ISO/TC 86 'Refrigeration and air-conditioning'**, responsible for international standardization in the field of refrigeration and air-conditioning.
- **CEN/TC 182 'Refrigeration systems, safety and environmental requirements'**, which standardises requirements in the field of safety and environment for the design, construction, installation, testing, operation, repair and disposal of refrigeration systems in Europe.

Tasks of the expert will include:

- To monitor the relevant work of the one or several specific technical committees;
- To participate in and present ECOS' views in the selected standardisation committee meetings and report back to ECOS Secretariat (circa 2-3 meetings a year);
- To prepare technical input and position papers in close collaboration with the ECOS Secretariat;
- To regularly exchange with interested ECOS member organisations and other experts (by e-mail).

Activities are expected to continue throughout 2015 and beyond.

The remuneration of the expert will be as follows:

- Daily expert fees (€ 400) for preparation, participation in meetings and reporting, as well as for any other tasks to be performed in between meetings;
- Per diems to cover accommodation and subsistence costs (€ 170);
- Reimbursement of travel costs.
