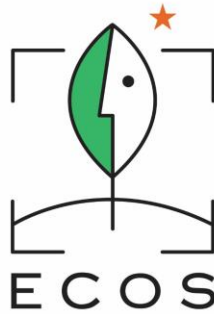

ECOS is looking for experts of Power Transformers and Industrial Fans to represent environmental interests in the [INTAS project](#). The project addresses the need to support European Market Surveillance Authorities deliver compliance with Ecodesign requirements for large industrial products, specifically power transformers and fans. Experts will provide technical and scientific input into discussions, and review project deliverables in accordance with the related policy context and ECOS strategy.

The experts should have expertise in one or both product groups below:

- **Power Transformers (covered by regulation (EU) no. 548/2014)**
- **Fans (covered by regulation (EU) no. 327/2011)**

The nominated experts will be responsible for:

- Assisting the project coordinator in evaluating documents, positions, and strategies of the project, using existing knowledge of the technical and mechanical variations in these product categories
- Providing technical input e.g. comments on project deliverables, position papers
- Preparing, where appropriate, technical evidence to support the above
- A full list of tasks will be negotiated with the successful candidate

Interested candidates should be able to illustrate an in-depth knowledge in the specific product group(s). Experience with, and understanding of, the EU Ecodesign and Energy Labelling Directives will be considered a strong asset. Candidates should also demonstrate a strong commitment to environmental NGO values. Fluency in English is a must.

ECOS offers up to 20 paid expert days over the course of 2017 and 2018. The final fee and number of days will be dependent on the expected duration of work and number of tasks.
