We ensure the environmental voice is heard when they are developed and **drive change** by providing expertise to policymakers and industry players, leading to the implementation of **strong environmental principles**.






What we want

Ecodesign for sustainable products

Building on our extensive work on ecodesign for electronics and household appliances, we inspired policy makers to extend the scope of this brilliant tool. The EU now intends to use ecodesign to cover sectors which have previously escaped dedicated environmental laws, such as construction, furniture and textiles.

Electric vehicles and sustainable batteries

Widespread uptake of electric vehicles is essentially good news for the climate – but it also comes with significant environmental challenges. We work to make sure that laws and standards support reusable batteries, and that vehicles are well integrated into the electricity grid through smart charging.





Plastics

As part of the Rethink Plastic alliance, ECOS campaigns to reduce our plastic footprint. We believe that plastic products should be clean and circular by design. We also help develop test methods, criteria, and regulatory targets to dramatically reduce microplastics emissions into the environment. Thanks to our work, the Single-Use Plastics Directive treats biodegradable plastic just like any other kind of plastic.

Cooling

All over the world, the phase-down of polluting refrigerating gases is ongoing. But the technical complexities of this switch are holding the transition back. ECOS works to develop a positive narrative on natural refrigerants, reduce the barriers posed by standards to their uptake, and increase ambition at policy level.



Guiding consumers and businesses

ECOS advocates for ambitious legislation to empower consumers and businesses in the green transition. We work to enable companies and investors to more accurately assess and communicate the impact of their activities, using mandatory and voluntary labels underpinned by environmentally strong assessments.





Sustainable Built Environment

ECOS is the only environmental NGO taking a holistic approach to building sustainability, using both policy and standards to address the enormous environmental impacts of buildings and construction products throughout their lifecycle, from sourcing of raw materials to end-of-life.


